On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

Chris Brausch, Sanitary Engineer, was present to discuss the following matters:

- 1. Mr. Brausch is requesting to move forward with the demolition of the Union Road Water Treatment Plant that has been obsolete for several years now. The Board advised him to move forward with getting the price quotes but to not take any action.
- 2. Hendrickson Road Water—There are several residents on Hendrickson Road that are requesting the extension of the waterline to serve their property. The preliminary estimates are approximately \$30,000 per benefitted household but the residents are requesting that a petition be sent the property owners. The Board stated they would not approve a \$30,000 assessment until 100% of all property owners were in favor of the project.

Lisa Evans, property owner in the City of Carlisle (200 Industry Drive), was present along with Greg Wallace, representative from the City of Carlisle, Matt Nolan, Prosecutor's Office, and Jerry Spurling, Chief Building Official, to discuss a construction elevation issue she has on her property.

Ms. Evans stated that her property was built in 1985 with all the required approvals at the time. She stated that the City of Carlisle had Flood Plain Regulations in place which applied to her property and that Warren County approved all building inspections.

Ms. Evans stated that the business has closed and the property was listed for sale and had an accepted contact for purchase. Upon title examination, it was determined that the building was constructed below flood elevation and therefore, any mortgage company would require flood insurance at a cost of approximately \$10,000 per year due to the elevation being below was is required in a flood plain.

Ms. Evans then stated that the purchaser walked away from the property which is now in foreclosure.

Mr. Spurling provided the Board with a copy of the approved zoning permit issued by the City of Carlisle relative to the Building Permit approval from 1985.

There was much discussion relative to Ms. Evans situation and upon discussion, the Board suggested she contact an attorney relative to any legal claims she may have and also requested Mr. Spurling to help Ms. Evans with any necessary actions she can take with FEMA to try to have her property removed from the flood plain.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
